Confession

This page is a guide to using our confessions of faith as a weapon of spiritual warfare and as a tool to access the things of God. We have been given precious promises, that through them we might “*partake of the divine nature* (2 Peter 1:1–4).” Our confessions do two things. They provide a means through which realities that exist in deep spiritual and quantum mechanical realms to become instantiated or manifested in our everyday world. They also provide a means to focus our faith.

Ch 1: Confessions Strengthening Faith

- 1) I am a child of God through faith in Christ, with the rights of Sons and Daughters (*Romans 8:14-16; Eph1:5; Gal3:26; Galatians 4:1-7*)

- 1) The blood of Jesus destroys the guilt of sin – I am forgiven
(*Matthew 26:28; Colossians 1:12-15; Romans 3:23-26*)

- 2) The blood of Jesus destroys Satan’s standing before God
(*Col 2:13-15*)

- 3) The blood of Jesus destroys the power of sin – I have been crucified with Christ (*Romans 6:1-9; Gal 2:20*).

- 4) I am righteous on the basis of the finished work of Christ.
(*2 Corinthians 5:21; Romans 4:21-24; 1 Corinthians 6:8-11; Philippians 3:8-9*).

- 5) The blood of Jesus destroys the power of the world system.
(*Col 2:20-22; 1 John 4:4; 1 John 5:4*).

- 6) The Lord who began a good work in me is faithful to complete it – He is the author and finisher of my faith (*Phillipians 1:6; Hebrews 12:1-2; Romans 8:28-30*).

- 7) The Lord works in me so I can will and do His good pleasure
(*Philippians 2:12-13*).

- 8) I am predestined to be conformed to the image of the Son of God
(*Romans 8:28-29*).

- 9) God has works He has predestined me to do (Eph 2:8–10; Romans 8:28–30).
- 10) God has promised to give me every good and perfect gift when I ask Him – especially his Holy Spirit
(Matthew 7:7–11; Matthew 21:21–22; Luke 11:9–13; James 4:2–3; 1 John 3:22–23; 1 John 5:14–15).
- 11) I am an overcomer, and I overcome through faith in Christ
(Romans 8:31–37; 1 John 5:4–5).
- 12) Christ has redeemed me to be a king and a priest. I have access to the Throne room now and I shall reign upon the earth alongside Jesus Christ (1 Peter 2:9; Revelation 1:5–6; 5:9–10)
- 13) The Eyes of the Lord is always watching me to see if I trust Him so that He may show His power, that is able to do beyond what we can imagine.(2 Chr 16:9; Ephesians 3:20–21)
- 14) I will trust Him (Proverbs 3:5–6; Jeremiah 17:5–8)
